Please note:

Kenneth E Kay DMD requires payment prior to the completion of your treatment. If you choose to discontinue care before treatment is complete, you will receive a refund less the cost of care received.

For plans requiring multiple appointments, alternative payment arrangements may be provided.

For patients with dental insurance we are happy to work with your carrier to maximize your benefit and directly bill them for reimbursement for your treatment.² However, we extend this as a courtesy to our patients and cannot guarantee payment or coverage by your insurance company.

A fee of \$50 is charged for patients who miss or cancel more than 2 times in a calendar year without 24-hour notice.

Any person who is financially responsible for another patient's bill is entitled to information about that patient's dental treatment., until such time as that patient is financially independent. At that time, information will no longer be disclosed without the patient's permission.
